Notice on Business Continuity Activities Following the Activation of the Business Continuity Plan (BCP)
(Third Report)

We would like to provide an update on the incident involving a tank explosion and fire that occurred at the Miyoshi Factory (Miyoshi City, Hiroshima Prefecture) of Maruzen Pharmaceuticals Co., Ltd. on April 28, 2026.

The fire involving the ethanol storage tank at the Miyoshi Factory has already been extinguished. We are currently cooperating with the relevant authorities to investigate the cause of the accident.

No employees of our company were injured. Several external contract workers were injured. However, it has been confirmed that none of the injuries are life-threatening. We sincerely wish those who were injured a speedy recovery.

For the purpose of on-site investigation, operations at the Miyoshi Factory have been temporarily suspended. However, starting May 8, shipments will be resumed for inventory stored in warehouses that have passed safety inspections. In addition, we are considering alternative production at other our facilities as well as outsourced production through external partners.

Please note that, depending on the product, confirmation and adjustment of manufacturing and equipment conditions may be required, and various factors may cause assumptions to change. We will provide explanations and make adjustments regarding individual shipment statuses on a case-by-case basis.

We sincerely apologize to local residents and all related parties for the significant concern and inconvenience caused.

Should any new information requiring disclosure become available, we will promptly provide further updates.
